The Asheville GO Training Team is a paid job training and placement program designed to prepare young adults (ages 16-24) for living wage jobs in the rapidly expanding Green Economy. Our hands-on curriculum combines community service projects, life skills training, and on-the-job experience in order to provide GO members with everything they need to launch successful careers in promising fields like **clean energy, green construction, recycling, ecological landscaping and restoration, and sustainable agriculture.**

Why GO?

The green economy is growing fast, creating thousands of new jobs that **pay a living wage**, offer **advancement opportunities**, and **serve the community and the planet**. Asheville GO will help you access these jobs through **hands-on** service-learning projects and on-the-job work experience.

- Community and environmental service projects
- Field trips, retreats and conferences
- One-on-one tutoring and counseling support
- Job shadowing and internships with local green employers
- Community college coursework individualized for each GO Member

What's the Commitment?

Asheville GO is a **nine-month** program, beginning this September and ending in May. GO members will be expected to work/train a minimum of 24 hours a week during Phase 1 (from September to December) and 32 hours a week during Phase 2. Specific program activities will vary significantly but will likely include the following:
